



<u>SAINT JOHN BOSCO</u> 16 August 1815 -31 January 1888 Feast Day, 31 January

Hailed as one of the greatest teachers of his time, **St. John Bosco**, or affectionately known to many as **Don Bosco**, viewed education as the means to help Christian youth find their place in corporate society. He was the master of classroom management, good discipline rooted in liberty, and a strong Catholic identity. When asked by his students how one could live a long and healthy life, his maxim consisted of four things: always have a clear conscience, moderation in eating, live an active life, and surround yourself with good companions.
