

May he rest in peace. A Mass will be celebrated at St Brigid's Church Marrickville on Wednesday evening, March 7th, at 7.00pm. A Mass will be celebrated at St Anthony in the Field's Church, Myoora Rd, Terry Hills on March 8th at 10.30 am.
