

CHRISTMAS MESSAGE

Firstly, we celebrate with thankfulness that the Lord is with us. Secondly, we celebrate with faith, that whatever hardships we may have to endure, God is with us and He will bring all things to their good. Finally, we share our great faith and hope in His love for all creation by wishing everyone a 'very Happy and blessed Christmas and a truly Joy filled New Year'.
