

The recent bombings and deaths in Sri Lanka have shocked many of us and whilst not all who died were Catholic, the majority were Catholic, and in keeping with Catholic tradition particularly in South Asia, the Diocese of Parramatta will celebrate a Month's Mind Requiem Mass to pray for all who were killed in Sri Lanka.

A Month's Mind Requiem Mass is typically celebrated one month after a person's death and is held in memory of the deceased. Very Rev Christopher de Souza will be celebrating this mass at St Nicholas of Myra Parish, Penrith on Sunday 19 May at 10am.
