Feast of Christ the King, also called Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, **King of the Universe, festival celebrated in the Roman Catholic Church in** honour of Jesus Christ as Lord over all creation.

This feast was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925 in response to the rise of totalitarianism. It falls on the final Sunday of the Liturgical Calendar, or on the last Sunday of October as celebrated by traditional Catholics.

It celebrates Christ's reign over the human race and human hearts. The feast emphasizes God's ultimate forgiveness as well as Christ's eschatological return and final sovereignty over all creation. This last theme is continued during Advent.
