

## **SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION REGISTRATION 2021 AT ST OLIVER'S**

Registration for candidates into the Sacrament of Confirmation 2021 are now open.

The Sacrament of Confirmation is the final step for completion of the Sacraments of Initiation. To be eligible for preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation at this time your child must be 10 years of age by 30th of June 2021 and have made their First Reconciliation and First Eucharist. While this is the minimum age for children to join in preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, it is important to note that there is no maximum age for children who have been baptized as infants to complete their Initiation into our Faith Community. It is important for you to discern if your child is ready to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation at this time. The family centered program will begin in Term 3 and throughout Term 4 with the ceremony taking place on **Sunday 21st November 10:00am**.
