COVID-19 REMINDERS:

Under the 80% vaccination roadmap:

- Those who are not vaccinated can attend religious services held in the church. This includes weddings and funerals.

FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR DEACON OWEN ROGERS

The Mass of Christian Burial for Deacon Owen Rogers will take place at Corpus Christi Parish, Cranebrook on Friday 12 November at 10am. All safeguarding and COVID-19 protocols will be observed. The Mass will also be livestreamed. Registration and the wearing of face masks is compulsory. Following the Mass, the cortege will proceed to the Penrith General Cemetery, Cox Avenue, Kingswood. As the cemetery is not a place of worship, the cemetery's COVID-19 Safety Plan requires that those attending the burial must be double vaccinated and must register with their QR code. A viewing will be held on Thursday 11 November from 5pm to 6pm, with Morning Prayer of the Office for the Dead to take place on Friday 12 November at 9.15am.
