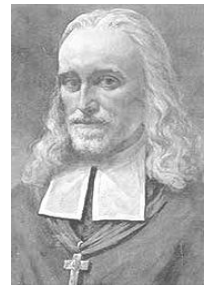

✠ **2 square metre rule per person**

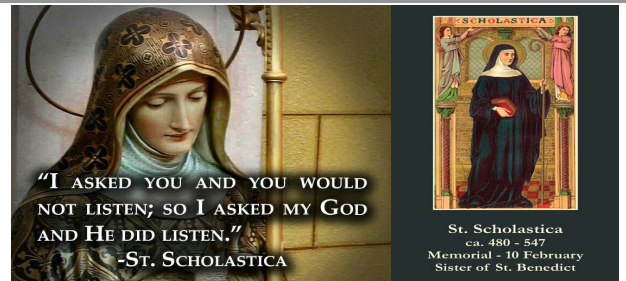
From 27 December, density limits of 1 person per 2 sqm will apply.
