

ASH WEDNESDAY, 2nd of March 2022

Ash Wednesday $(2^{nd}$ March 2022) is the **beginning of Lent**. Lent is the great annual peni-tential season in the Catholic Church for prayer, self-denial and helping others. This is the way the whole church prepares annually to celebrate Easter. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence.



The law of fasting binds those who have completed their eighteenth year, until the beginning of their sixtieth year. Fasting means having one full meal and two smaller meals that together are Not equal to a full meal. The law of **abstinence** binds those who have completed their **fourteenth year**. Abstinence means **refraining**

from eating meat (or luxury foods). Also, Catholics are obliged to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion at least once between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday.

Please read the following adjustments to COVID-19 settings:

† Face masks

Masks are no longer required but wearing of face masks at places of worship continues to be strongly recommended, especially indoors and when social distancing is not possible.

† Check-In with the QR Code

Check-in using the NSW QR Code and record keeping of all attendees are no longer required for places of worship.

* No More 2 square metre rule per person

No more density limits (previously one person per 2sqm rule) but keeping a safe distance from others not in your household is highly recommended.

† Congregational singing is allowed.

† Wash your hands with soap & water regularly or Use hand sanitiser
