Calling the St. Olivers Parish Family to a Community Morning Tea every 1st Sunday of the Month after the 10am mass.



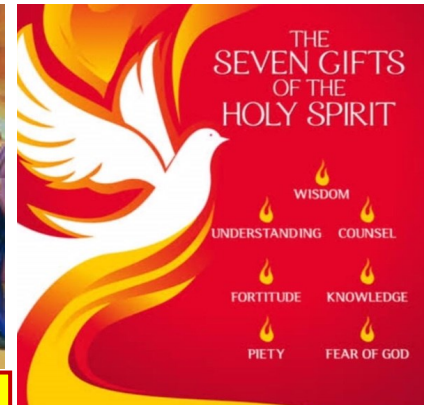
