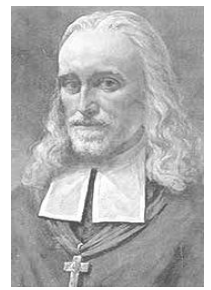

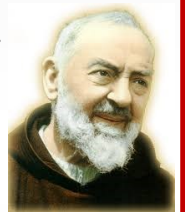

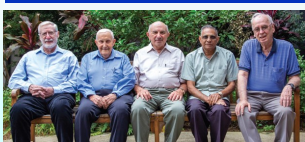


GLENMORE PARK ST PADRE PIO PARISH FEAST DAY CELEBRATIONS

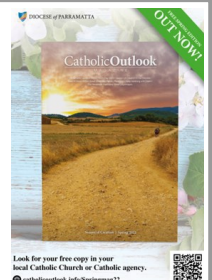
