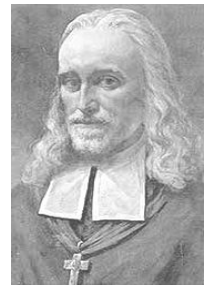

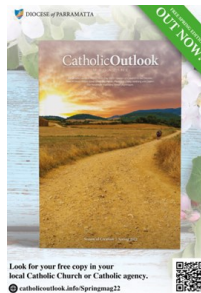
Catholic Outlook has claimed four awards at the 2022 Australasian Catholic Press Association (ACPA)
