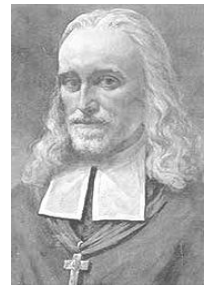

The Public Rosary is an international campaign to pray the rosary together in commemoration of the last apparition of Our Lady at Fatima (October 13, 1917). 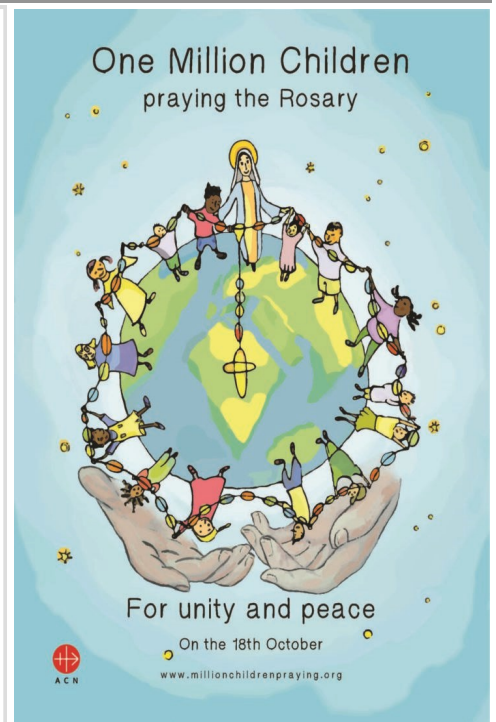

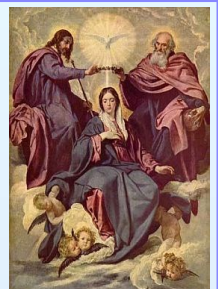
ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF COUNTRY
