Cardinal Pell at St Patrick's Cathedral Parramatta in 2011. Australian Bishops react to news of passing of former Prefect of the Vatican Secretariat for the Economy on Tuesday, January 10, at the age of 81, after suffering complications following hip replacement surgery. Pope Francis recalled Pell's "consistent and committed witness, his dedication to the Gospel and to the Church, and particularly his diligent cooperation with the Holy See in its recent economic reform, for which he laid the foundations with determination and wisdom."

Archbishop Anthony Fisher OP said he was "Australia's most prominent ever churchman, having provided strong and clear leadership within the Catholic Church in Australia, as Archbishop of Melbourne and Archbishop of Sydney." Archbishop Fisher stated that Cardinal Pell was "a fine priest, a good Christian soul."
