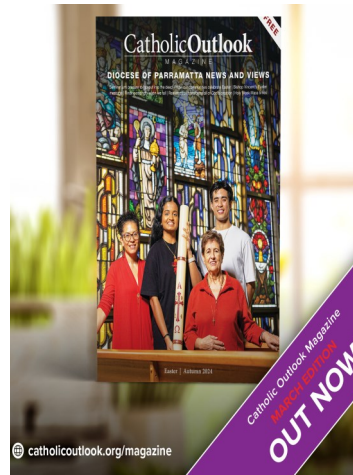
HAIL HOLY QUEEN
